

Check the symptoms today. Cancer could be cured if caught early enough.



Ovarian cancer is a tumour that develops in the ovaries.

Theres no screening for Ovarian cancer, visit your GP as soon as something doesn't feel right or you have one of the symptoms.

Symptoms

Ovarian cancer symptoms include frequently (roughly 12 or more times a month) having:

- A swollen tummy or feeling bloated
- Pain or tenderness in your tummy or the area between the hips (pelvis)
- No appetite or feeling full quickly after eating
- An urgent need to pee or needing to pee more often

Tests

- Blood tests CA125
- Ultrasound scan
- Taking a sample of tissue called a biopsy
